The iFLOWS project achieved a successful in-person plenary meeting in Berlin, with the following primary objectives:

- ✓ Assess the first six months progress per work package and project as a whole
- ✓ Identify the inter-dependences amongst the work packages of the project
- ✓ Identify and analyze real life use cases and exchange know-how on the key threats and challenges
- ✓ Define a work plan for the next 6 months







During the meeting of iFLOWS project, presentations were delivered highlighting the proposed improvements to the scanner mechanism utilized for identifying illegal substances in postal and courier services.


Sharing of 99 business user cases led to the development of 18 key performance indicators and 59 measures of effectiveness, aimed at streamlining threat and risk assessment and automating parcel and data analysis. These outputs are designed to simplify the process analysis while reducing the possibility of risks and threats.

The team focused on defining ongoing user-case scenarios and exploring partnerships with other stakeholders to gather more information needed for customizing iFLOWS system architecture. Additionally, legal and human aspects that are crucial for the project's progress were discussed.

The meeting ended with a discussion about the collaboration with other EU-funded projects that share similar goals, in order to enhance our tools, methodologies, and overall awareness and communication efforts.

The iFLOWS partners have set the date for the upcoming project meeting, which is scheduled for November 2023.
